in my afflictions.*

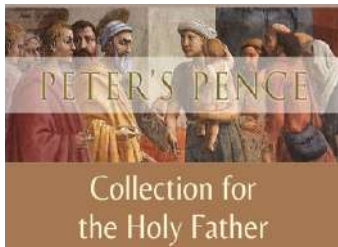
*Give me health of

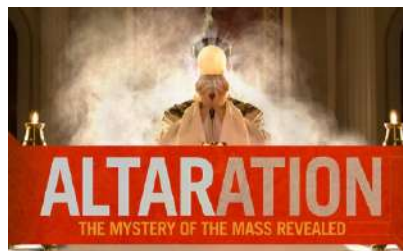
