The fifth talk "GOD'S LOVE", is to take place on Friday 30 July after 9am Mass in the Church.



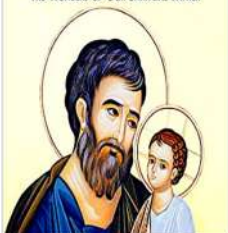
ANOINTING MASS Friday 6 August at 9am
