### **ANOINTING OF THE SICK MASS**

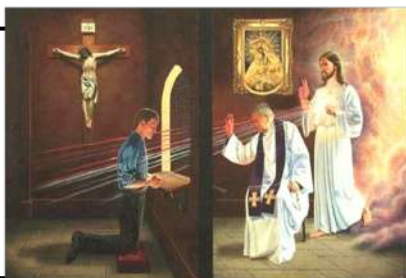
