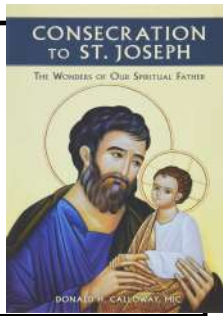


CONSECRATION TO ST JOSEPH, THE WORKER

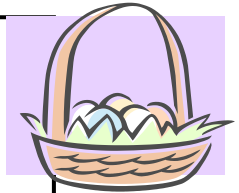
