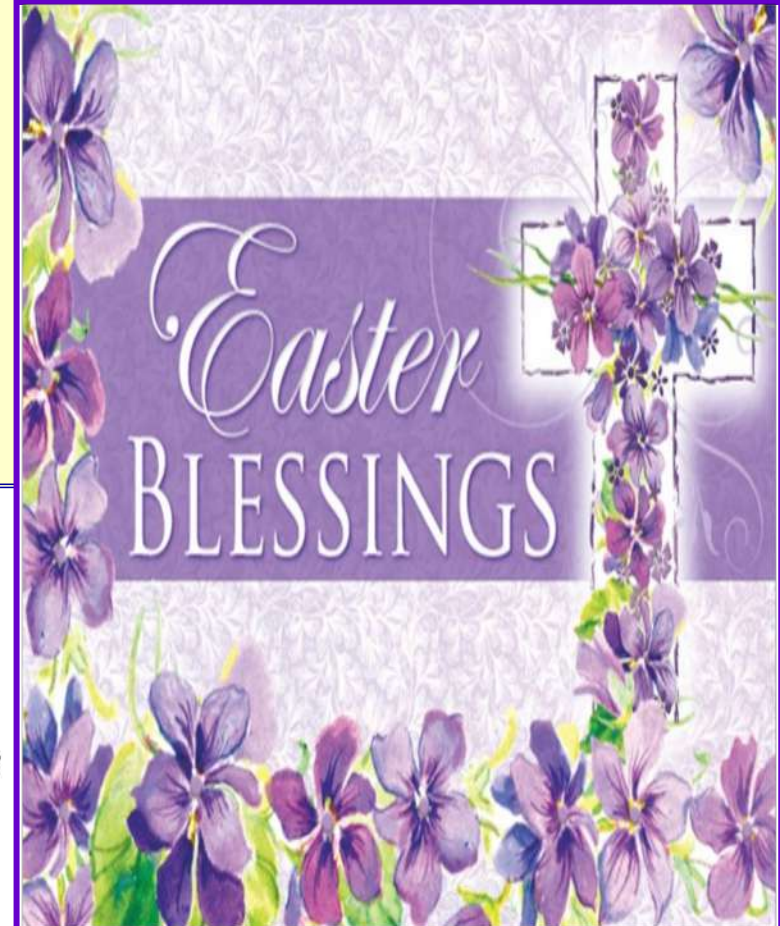

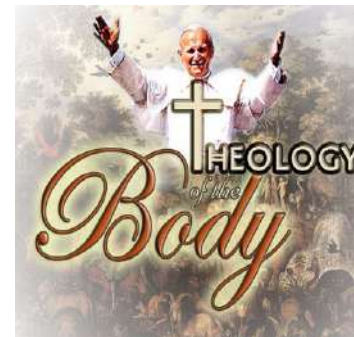
PARISHIONER BEREAVEMENT
