loving of all mothers forget me?

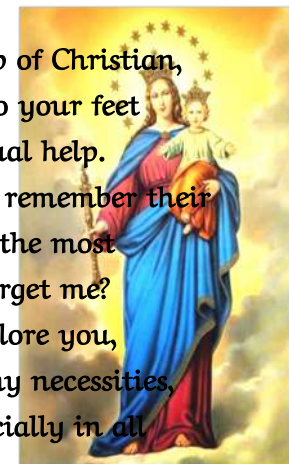
Grant then to me, I implore you,
