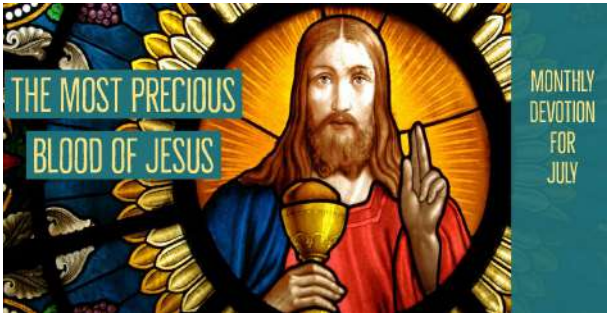

Introduction to the Gospel Luke 10:1-12,17-20
 In last Sunday's Gospel Jesus sends 3 would-be disciples away; today he sends 70 disciples out. His refusal to compromise with the 3 aspiring followers carries over into the instructions he gives the missionaries. They're being sent "like lambs among wolves". They're to carry nothing with them. They have to take their chances with hospitality. They may not be made welcome. The sense of urgency is palpable, for "the Kingdom of God is very near". The longer version goes to spell out the judgment that will be handed down for those who reject them. It also includes the disciples' report of their success and Jesus' confirmation that the satanic powers holding the world hostage are already being disarmed. The reference to "serpents & scorpions and the whole strength of the enemy" brings to mind the assurances Jesus gives to the Eleven when he commissions them at the end of Mark's Gospel (16:18). Both the longer and the shorter texts finish on a positive note. Whichever is chosen, this gospel is a clarion call for the people of God to be bearers of peace, agents of healing and heralds of good news.
