Gospel Matthew 13:44-52

The Kingdom of Heaven is like treasure hidden in a field.

Also, the Kingdom of Heaven is like a merchant in search of fine pearls. Again, the Kingdom of Heaven is like a net thrown into the sea, which collects fish of every kind.

The Kingdom of Heaven is likened to a net that gathers all people at the end of the age and separates them, the good from the bad. In the end, for those who enter the glories of Heaven, there will be unending joy. And this fact must be understood so as to draw us into those riches of grace.
